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Project's activities

- 1- Capacity Building: Goat and Sheep Shepherds, Forages producers, students of Technical Schools, dairy products' producers, 3 agricultural cooperatives and 13 SMEs are provided with technical training, financial literacy training and life skills training.
- 2- Farmers are provided with materials and extension services to enhance <u>production capacity</u> and quality
- 3- Farmers and food processing beneficiaries are provided with marketing and market linkages skills and are encouraged to adopt new marketing strategies to access new market opportunities
