

## Approach and Methodology

**MERAVIGLIA** is built on an integrated approach, combining strong local roots, based on the analysis of socio-economic and environmental needs, with the co-construction of actions alongside local stakeholders and communities. It emphasizes transnational cooperation to promote the sharing of practices, mobility, and intercultural mentoring. The program ensures that methods and tools can be replicated and adapted across the Mediterranean region to support entrepreneurs and productive units.



## Expected results

- An innovative model of Third Places dedicated to environmental skills
- To create or strengthen 12 Third Places across partner territories to support the development of green skills and local innovation
- To develop a virtual academy dedicated to green entrepreneurship, facilitating access to resources, training, and experience sharing
- To design transnational training pathways combining e-learning, mentoring, and hands-on practical experiences to strengthen professional capacities
- To establish 4 eco-entrepreneur residencies promoting intercultural learning, experimentation, and the co-creation of sustainable solutions
- To produce policy recommendations aimed at enhancing the impact, sustainability, and long-term continuity of the actions undertaken
